Conservation

TVFF is very active in conservation projects to preserve our fishing heritage. Our "signature" project is participation in the DF&G "Trout in the Classroom" program in which students raise trout from fertilized eggs in their classrooms in TVFF-donated aquariums. TVFF supports the program in over 20 local classrooms.

The students learn that the fish need good clean water, a natural food source and quality habitat to survive. They develop a strong bond with the young fish, which is very evident when they release them back to the river. See the Education page of the TVFF web site for more information.

Funds raised by TVFF's monthly raffle and annual auction are donated to various conservation groups, such as California Trout, Alameda Creek Alliance, and other worthy causes.

Recreation

TVFF hosts monthly fishing outings throughout Northern California and beyond. Members with experience in various locations and species of fish act as a "fishmasters" to organize the logistics of the outing and share their knowledge.

Fishing with experienced anglers on outings is one of the best ways to learn and build your fly fishing skills. Enjoy fishing at such locations as the Upper Sacramento and Trinity Rivers, the Delta, Manzanita and Pyramid Lakes, and other locations. Fish species include trout, steelhead, largemouth bass, striped bass, and more.
